- \$6.00/scout (min. \$45/program)

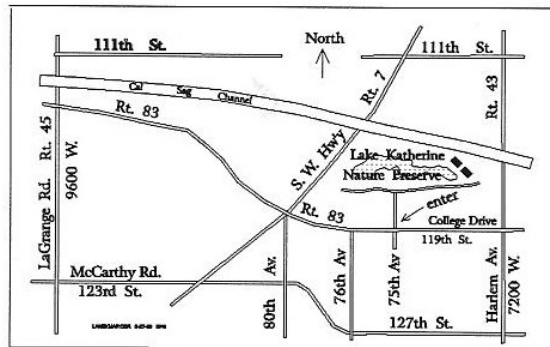
Program prices may vary/have an additional fee of \$1/scout that does not count towards the minimum fee.
